

Making Ten

OBJECTIVE

Be the first person to make 10 with all your cards

HOW TO PLAY

2 players per deck (without Kings, Queens, & Jacks)

The deck is split evenly between two players. Students lay out 4 cards and try to make ten with 2 or 3 cards (ex. 3 and 7 or 8, Ace and Ace). Once they make ten, they place it in the done pile. They must keep 4 cards in play at all times. If they cannot make ten, they can swap out a card and place that one on the bottom of the pile. If they come across a 10 card, they can use that as a “freebie.”

WINNING

The first who makes ten with all their cards, wins! OR the person who has the most pairs after they’ve gone through their deck.
