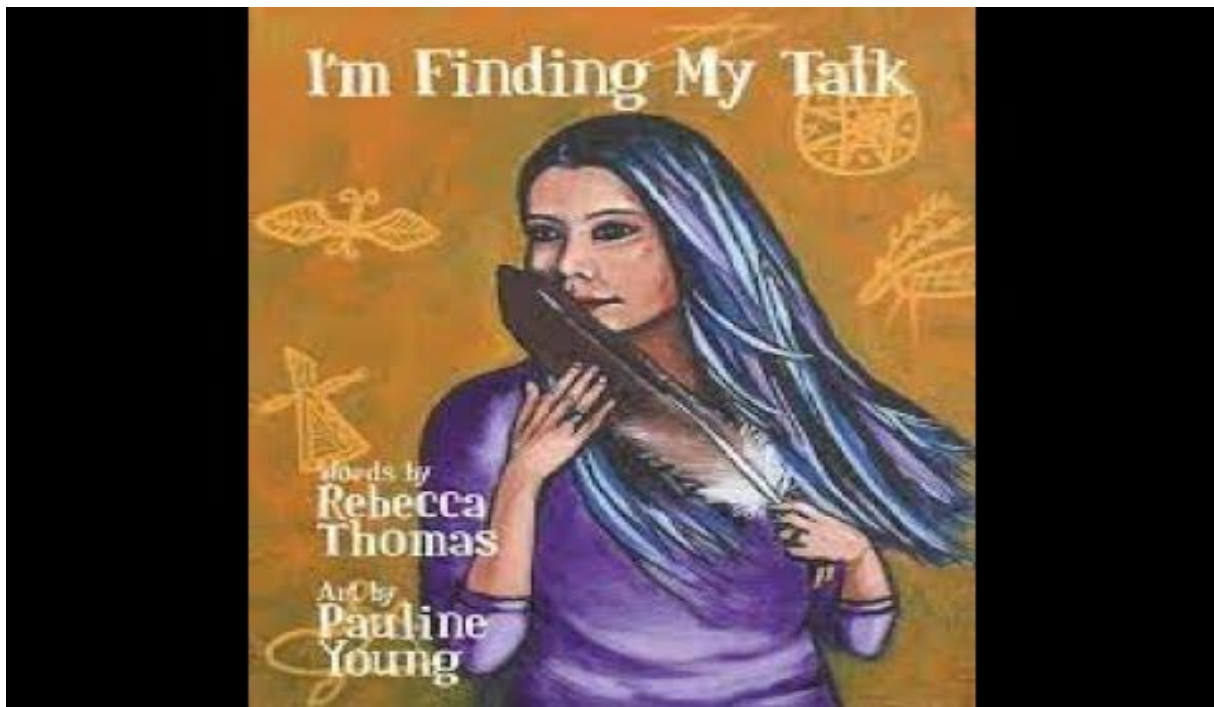
1) Tumble Books:
