
## STEM Project Resources

## Student Project Submission \*

Registration for student projects opens on Feb. 24th and closes Mar. 19th. Students who participate in this district event will be judged and Gr. 6-12 students are eligible to advance to the NB Provincial Science Fair in Fredericton April 2nd. They may enter in either of the two categories: Discovery or Innovation. A tri-fold board is required but a report is not at this level. Evidence of the process in the form of a science journal is recommended.

Maximum number of projects that can be registered from your school is 8 projects at each of the grade levels: 3-5, 6-8, 9-12





## Showcase Submission 🖔



Showcase submissions are open to K-12 students and classes to highlight some of the amazing Science and STEM learning happening in their school. These projects are not judged in the district event but students participating have the opportunity to share their learning, participate in

STEM activities, and are eligible for door prizes during the day.

Maximum of 4 students per showcase. K-5 students will need to have an adult supervisor in attendance.
