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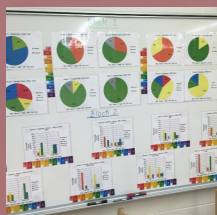

Grade 10—Provincial assessment; May 9-20th

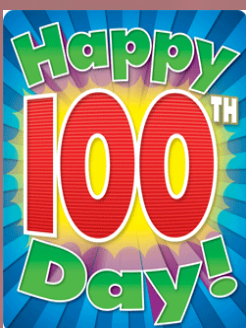
*District Benchmark results for Grades 5-8 have been released and our K-3 Key Skills will be out shortly.

Natoaganeg's Data Wall and School Wide Intervention



Natoaganeg First Nation has taken the collection and use of data to a whole new level. The data wall pictured here is prominently displayed in the hallway for students, teachers, and parents to see. After collecting the data from various assessments such as Math Key Skills and District Benchmark Assessments, teachers meet in teams to decide how to best meet the needs of struggling learners and enrich those who are ready to move forward. Students are then grouped for 30 minutes each day for 3-4 weeks for targeted intervention on specific outcomes. The goal is to ensure all students reach proficiency and/or mastery on all outcomes. This has been paying great dividends as Natoaganeg's results on our District Benchmark Assessments have soared. Keep up the great work meeting the needs of all learners Natoaganeg!
